Amendment of Ordinance # 2-86 Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance

At a Regular scheduled meeting of the Chippewa Cree Tribal Business Committee on January 4, 2007, Ordinance #2-86 was amended as follows;

"Section 2: Definitions

Addition I. Non-Resident: A person who has not resided on the Rocky Boy Indian Reservation for ninety days prior to employment.

"Section 11. Employment Right Fee


Addition D. Work Permit/Registration Fee

All non-resident employees of covered employers within the exterior boundaries of the Rocky Boy Indian Reservation shall apply and register to work within the exterior boundaries of the Rocky Boy Indian Reservation and pay a fee of \$100.00 per calendar year. This fee shall not apply to education, health, governmental, or non-profit employers, or to utilities franchised by the Chippewa Cree Tribe.

CERTIFICATION

The foregoing Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance #2-86 as amended was duly adopted on January 5, 2007 by a vote of ~~Eight (8)~~ members for and ~~(0) Zero~~ members Against by the Business Committee of the Chippewa Cree Tribe, pursuant to Authority vested in or by Section 1-p, Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on November 2, 1935, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
